

Dog Policy

We welcome (well-trained) dogs for a small charge. One dog (not over 35kg) is welcome in designated accommodation at an additional cost of £25 per stay. Payment will be taken at time of booking.

You must tell us if you are bringing a dog with you.

You must bring your dog's basket/bed, food and water bowls with you.

Your dog(s) are not allowed on beds or furniture, or in any domestic facilities you share with other visitors, such as communal apartment kitchens.

You must not leave any pets unattended in the property, including outdoors, and you must keep dogs on a lead within the boundaries of campus grounds.

Any fouling must be cleared up without delay.

We don't accept dogs listed under the Dangerous Dogs Act which are: Pit Bull Terrier, Dogo Argentino, Fila Brasileiro and Japanese Tosa. In addition to covering these four specific breeds, this act also extends to include any dog that appears to be a cross of these four breeds

If you have a dog that's noisy or behaving badly, we may ask you to take them away, so please keep your dog on a lead and under strict control and make sure a responsible adult is looking after it.

Please bear in mind that you won't be able to take your dog (unless it is an assistance dog) into our areas that serve food, sports venues or Macroberts Arts Venue.

Any damage (which must be reported to us immediately) or excessive cleaning will incur an additional charge.
